

SECTION - 7 | TECHNICAL & VOCATIONAL EDUCATION AND TRAINING

In the year 2006, 68,875 youth were recruited for Technical and Vocational Training in selected public training organizations. Majority (61%) of recruitments were males. The Vocational Training Authority recruited 12,501 males and 8,956 females. As shown in the table 7.1, 32,391 trainees completed their training in 2006.

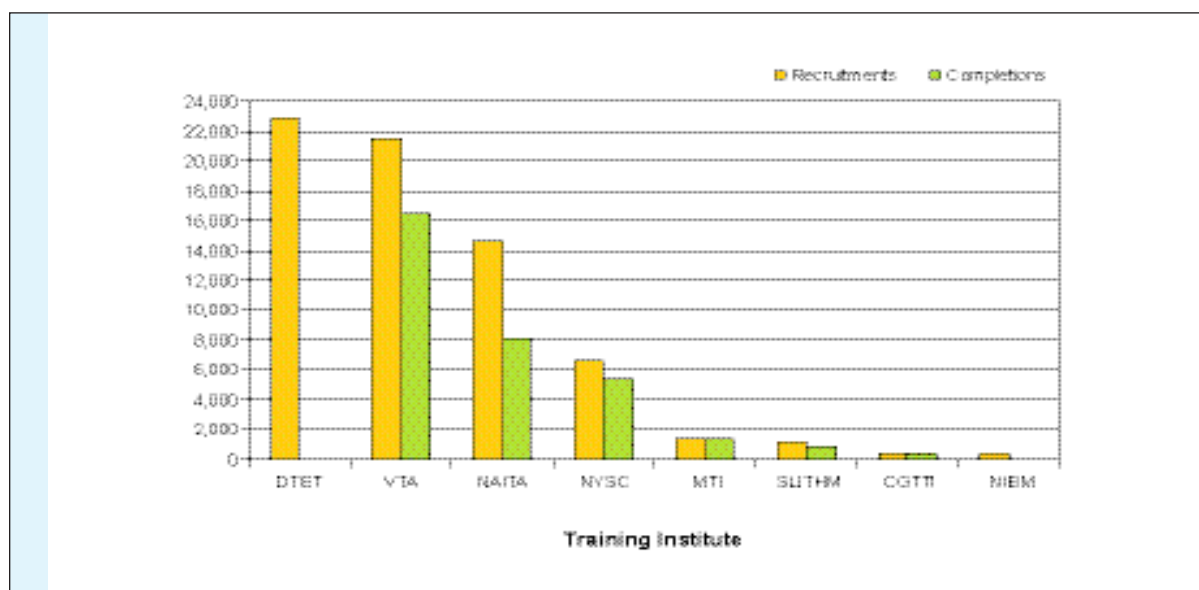

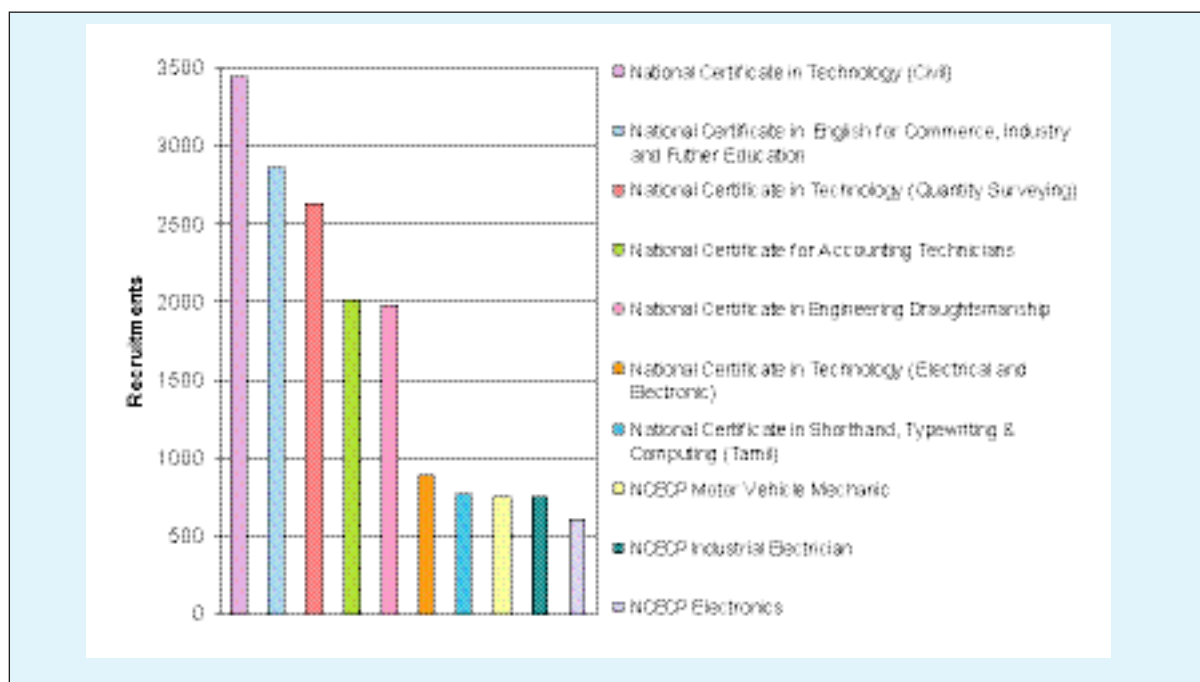

Graph 7.3 : Recruitments and Completions in National Apprenticeship and Industrial Training Authority of Sri Lanka in 2006

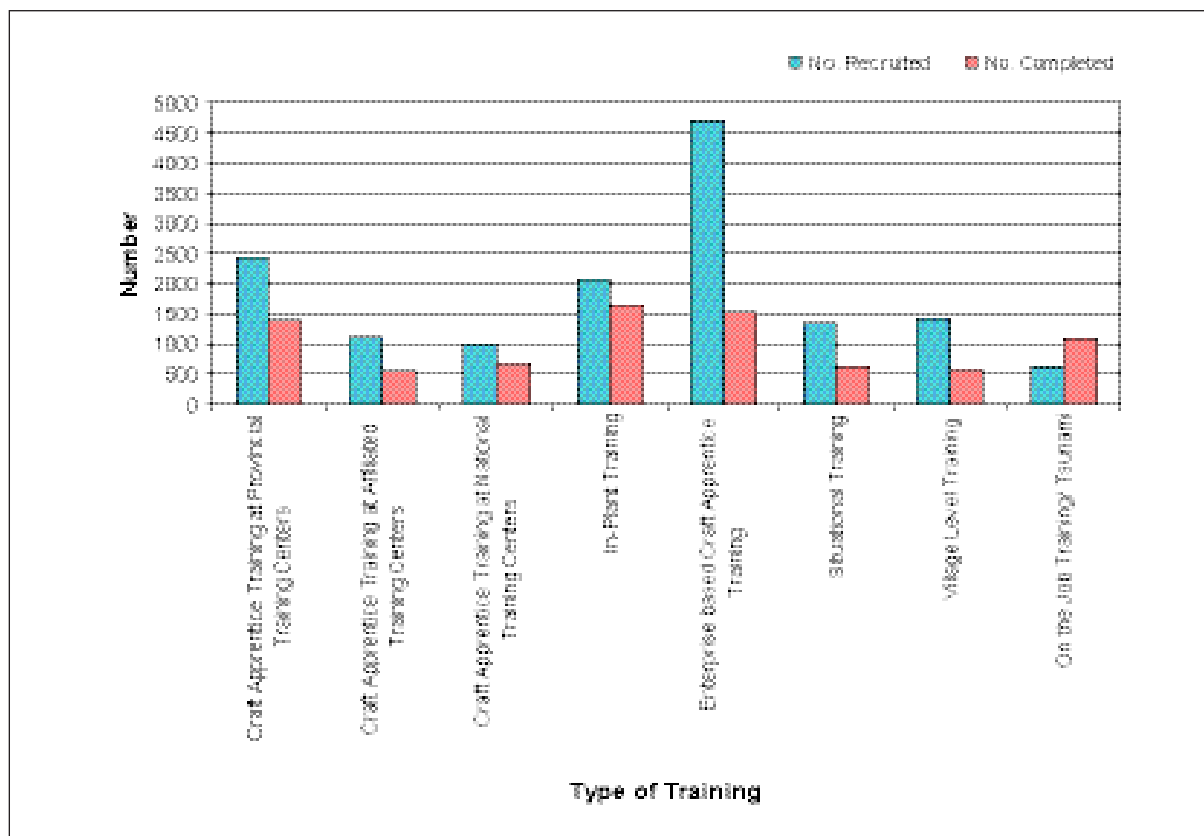

Graph 7.4 : Gender Distribution of the Completions by Province at the Vocational Authority of Sri Lanka in 2006

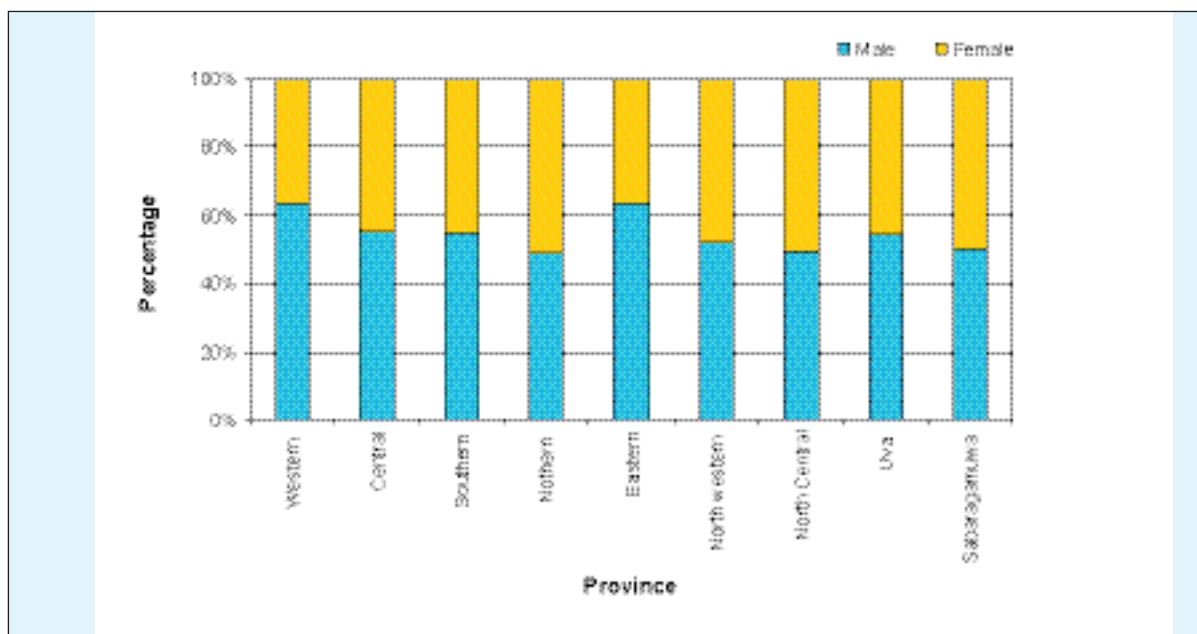
